It's hard to solve a problem you can't see. Until recently microplastic pollution presented scientists with a crisis that was invisible to the naked eye. Now we have AUSMAP, Australian Microplastic Assessment Project.

By translating data into detailed maps of plastic pollution hotspots all over Australia, AUSMAP makes it easy for everyone to see the scale and nature of this growing problem.

We need to know how much is already out there, before we figure out what to do with it. And we need large numbers of Australians to engage with behaviour change so we can stop any more plastic disintegrating into our waterways.

That's why AUSMAP is a collaborative citizen science project. Together we can all do something to clean up our rivers and oceans.



Learn about AUSMAP and participate in a full-day training session at Illawarra EEC. Participants will be trained in the sampling methodology for collecting, sorting and identifying microplastics.
